AHC Inc. Named One of Best NonProfit Organizations to Work for in U.S.

(Arlington, VA) – AHC Inc., a nonprofit affordable housing developer based in Arlington, VA, was recently named one of the *2010 Best NonProfit Organizations to Work for* by The NonProfit Times and Best Companies Group.

The national survey and award program identifies and honors the best places of employment in the nonprofit sector each year. The *2010 Best NonProfit Organizations to Work for* award program recognizes 50 organizations of varying sizes around the country; AHC is ranked #10 overall and #5 in the medium-size employers category (25 -249 employees). AHC, with 54 employees, has developed and preserved 34 properties in the mid-Atlantic region with more than 4,400 apartments.

“AHC’s wonderful mission – to build affordable housing and strong futures – combined with a strong compensation structure gives us a great mix,” says Walter D. Webdale, president and CEO. “Plus we really care about our employees and try to provide plenty of opportunities for personal and professional growth, as well as new initiatives, like health and wellness programs, to keep things fresh.”

Organizations from around the country entered the two-part survey process to determine the *Best NonProfit Organizations to Work for*. The first part consisted of evaluating each nominated organization’s workplace policies, practices, philosophy, systems and demographics. The second part consisted of an employee survey to measure the employee experience. The combined scores determined the top organizations and the final ranking.
