### Barclay Greenmount Hosts City Summer Food Program

#### Program Fills Gap When Schools are Closed



With good nutrition essential to a child's growth and development, GBAHC's Barclay Greenmount Apartments joins other community organizations throughout Baltimore as a site for the city's 2008 Summer Food Service Program (SFSP). The program provides nutritious breakfasts and lunches five days a week to low-income children under age 18. The program runs from June 16th through August 15th. The meals are freshly prepared and delivered daily to the sites by Martin's Caterers.

"We will serve the meals in our newly renovated community room, at the corner of Guilford and E. Lafayette Streets," said Shirley Dendy, President of the Barclay Greenmount Residents Association. "For some children around here, this is the only meal they are guaranteed while school is out. We expect to serve up to

75 children each day."

This year, students from YouthWorks, a city employment program, will help with SFSP as well as organizing games and activities for the children at Barclay Greenmount. PAL, the Police Athletic League, is also developing a chess program for youth at the property.
