Larger Offices Allow Room to Grow

Construction continues on the buildout of GBAHC's new office space in the historic Railway Express Building on St. Paul Street, adjacent to Penn Station. With the move to new, larger quarters -- over 3,000 square feet -- GBAHC plans to expand their current capabilities in affordable multifamily housing development and add homeownership programs, property management and asset management.
