## GBAHC Expands Revitalization Efforts in Park Heights

In addition to purchasing six vacant houses to rehabilitate and resell for first-time homebuyers, GBAHC has been named a qualified developer by the City and [Park Heights Renaissance \(PHR\)](#) and can participate in the Park Heights Single Family Homeownership program. [MonteVerde Apartments](#), also owned by GBAHC, is located one block from the recently purchased vacant homes.



GBAHC is working with the City's [Vacants to Values program](#) to alleviate vacant properties in Park Heights. This revitalization effort will be funded by GBAHC and AHC with assistance from the [Enterprise Foundation](#) and [NeighborWorks](#).
